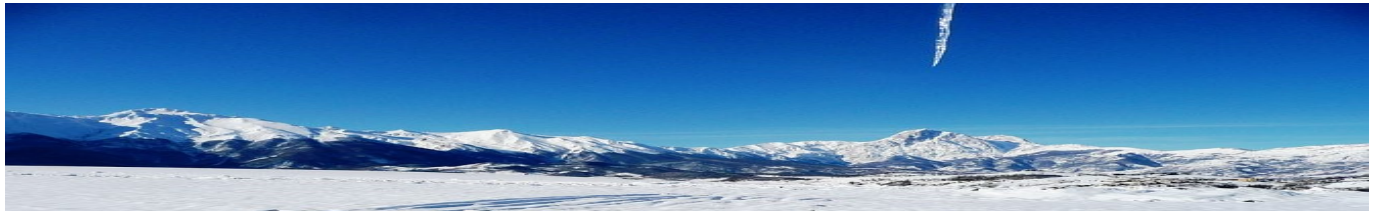

### **January meeting**

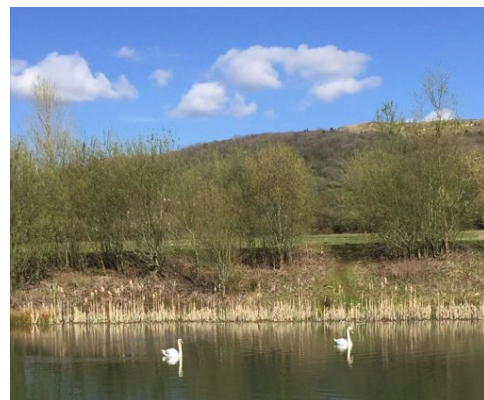
