This will be on August 14th at a cost of £3-00. A cheese platter and nibbles plus a glass of prosecco or squash will be provided. You may also bring your own drinks.

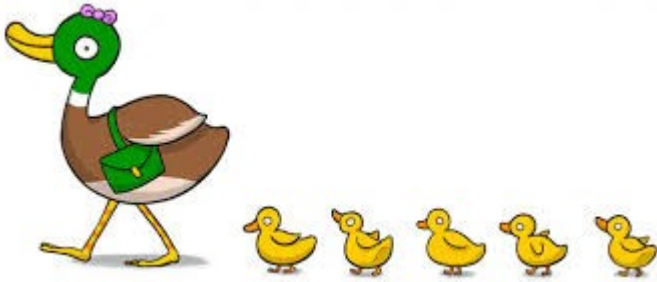
Fire Practice
